Site description: Location and surroundings

- Location (e.g. flat ground, slope, prominence, terrace)
- Altitude
- Orientation (N,S,E,W) if appropriate
- Land use (e.g. moor, rough grazing, improved pasture, arable, woodland)
- Other physical surroundings (e.g. proximity to a burn, modern farmhouse, other archaeological features)

Site description (continued): Summary

- Total number of buildings, enclosures, other structures (refer to 'Type of Site' section, above)
- Building shapes (e.g. rectangular, oval, circular)
- Outside and inside corners (rounded or square)
- Building materials (turf, stone or both; if stone, dressed or undressed, what sort)
- Masonry (dry stone, mortared, coursed, un-coursed)
- Condition of remains (e.g. upstanding, footings only etc)
- Maximum surviving height (approx)
- Roofed or unroofed (if roofed, what with)
- Other evidence for roof type (e.g. gables, cruck slots, thack-stane etc)
- Other observations

Site description (continued): Details

Include: size and shape of individual buildings and other structures (length x breadth), wall thickness and height - metric)

Features (e.g. fireplaces, cruck slots, wall cupboards)

Phasing (e.g. blocked doors and windows, inserted walls)

Functions (if known - e.g. byre-house, barn, mill, kiln)
